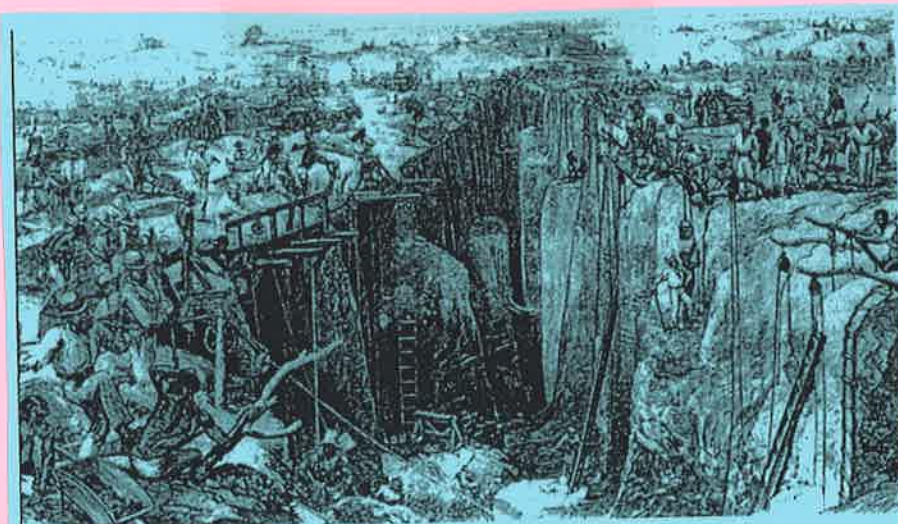

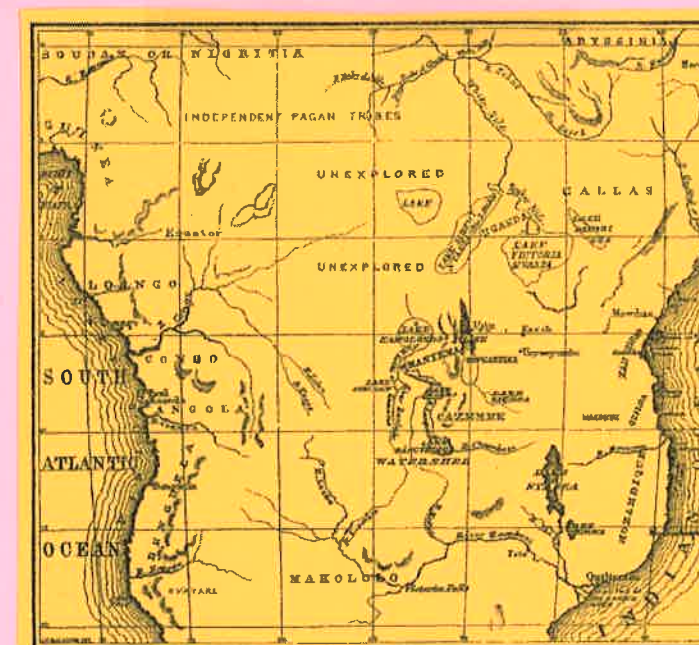


A Methodist Christian Sunday School at Guiongua, Angola, 1925

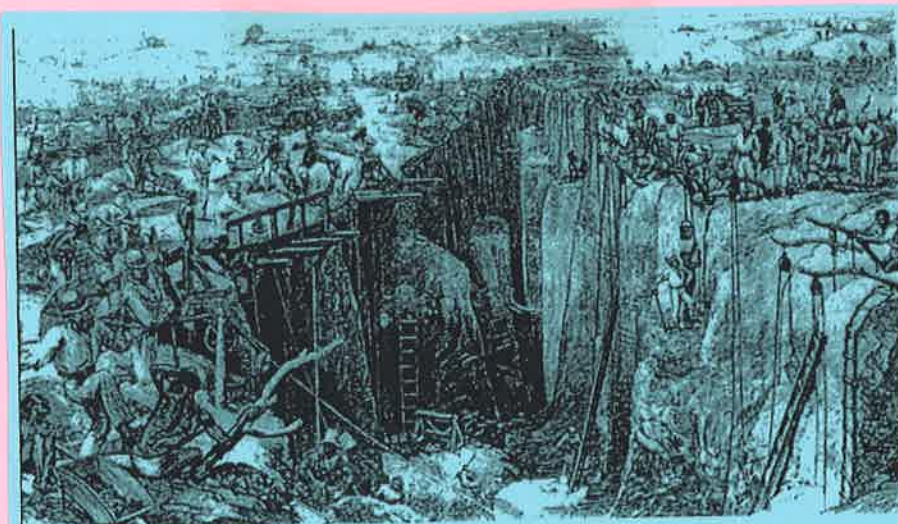

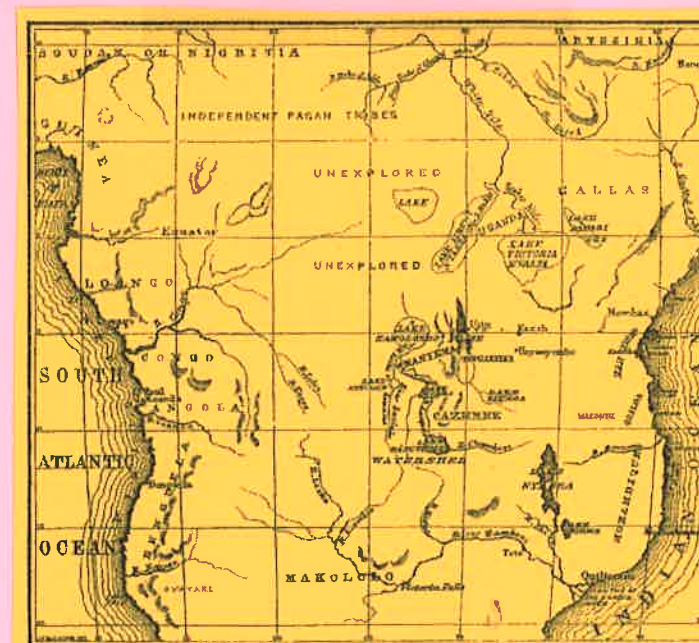
